Live Cell Biosensor for GPCR Studies

The GloSensor[™] cAMP Assay provides a simple and powerful new way to measure cAMP levels in cells. cAMP is a key second messenger involved in GPCR signaling, acting through G_g⁻ and G_l-coupled proteins. The assay uses a genetically modified form of firefly luciferase containing a cAMP-binding protein moiety. Binding of cAMP causes a conformational change that leads to increased light output. The assay is well suited to HTS and uHTS platforms.

Simple, Scalable Protocol

The GloSensor™ cAMP Assay is a 'zero step', nonlytic, live-cell assay ideal for kinetic and modulation studies of signaling through cAMP. The simple protocol is easily scalable to your throughput needs.

- 1. **Pre-equilibrate** cells with GloSensor™ cAMP Reagent for ~2 hours.
- 2. **Treat** cells with specific agonists/antagonists or library compounds.
- 3. Measure luminescence after 15–30 minutes.
